Will Virus Terrorism Ever End?

Probably not any time soon. Viruses are relatively easy to create, the culprits are difficult to trace, and the work they plant continues to spread automatically long after the original deed.

The best offense is therefore a good computer defense. The month of May was especially nasty for viruses, our shop has been busy with a daily flow of computers needing to be cleaned.

So what's up? Isn't the OCS system supposed to be taking care of this for our subscribers? Yes and no.

Our system has long protected against viruses attached to email, but we have warned that there are other vulnerabilities that bypass email. That is the nature of the BLASTER and SASSER viruses. They don't use email at all, but rather look for unprotected computers to attack directly when they are online.

This was a minimal issue in the days of dialup. Connecting and then disconnecting opens only a small period of vulnerability, especially when every session is assigned a different IP address.

But now that increasing numbers of Internet subscribers are using broadband services like DSL, cable, or fixed wireless, those computers are typically online all the time, 24x7, and often with the same IP address.

In response, computer hackers have designed automated snoops that prowl the Internet constantly, at very high speed, in search of computers that have essentially left their doors unlocked. When they find one, they let themselves in and plant their bugs.

FIREWALLS

How can this be prevented? With the use of a firewall that locks your computer's doors to all intruders other than friendly traffic.

OCS uses a sophisticated firewall to control all traffic into and out of our internal office network. For our wireless customers we offer the same option, which can be activated via UserAdmin. Wireless users who caught the recent SASSER virus recently only were those who did not activate or had disabled their OCS firewall option, while also not running a firewall on their own computers. The solution in those cases is obvious.

DIALUP CHANGES

At the same time, we're making a change for our dialup subscribers. So many were affected by SASSER that we think it is no longer enough to simply recommend running a local firewall, we need to make it easier to do so. The virus terrorists are becoming smarter, so we need to be more proactive. Otherwise, what our shop and many of our customers experienced in May is only going to become a more normal experience, which is unacceptable.

So, we have now modified our central firewall option in UserAdmin

to make it available to dialup subscribers as well as those with full-time wireless service.

FIREWALL ACTIVATION

To activate central firewall protection for your computer, simply go to Subscribers > User Admin on our home page main menu, enter your master account login and password, and click OACYS Firewall under Optional Services.

On the next page, several firewall configuration options are listed, as well as a disclaimer describing limitations. Simply click a selection to set your preferred level of firewall protection.

Please note that this service is free to our subscribers, but it is optional and set to OFF by default. Why optional? Because some people would prefer to manage their own firewalls, and in some cases there can be conflicts between systems. Should you experience a problem connecting with an online program, you can try disabling your firewall temporarily. If that resolves it, don't forget to turn your firewall back on as soon as possible!

The OACYS firewall is not yet available for dialup via our nationwide roaming numbers, we expect to have that available soon.

Password Insecurity

OK, all of you whose passwords aren't as secure as they should be, raise your hand. Uh-huh. Thought so, almost everyone.

The basics of password security aren't complicated. Don't share them. Don't write them down – particularly not on a Post-It note or your desk blotter. Don't use the same password for multiple sites. Don't pick something obvious, like a family birthday or a spouse's name or some combination. Don't pick a word that you can find in a dictionary. Don't pick something that only has letters – or even letters and numbers

Here's a tip. This is no substitute for the kind of good password practices you should employ, but at least it will take one vulnerability off the list – make sure none of your high-value passwords are used in low-value situations. In other words, don't use the password that unlocks your PayPal account to log yourself into a message board on a general-interest site, or to register for a free newspaper.

For low-value situations, figure out some kind of scheme that will let you use a different but easily remembered password in each case – such as a mnemonic or acronym plus the first few letters of the site.

To be clear, this isn't great security. You really should do far more than this. But if you're password-lax and fear you won't change, it's a start.
